Dear Parent/Carer,

I would like to welcome all families back to Temple Moor for the start of the new academic year. We have made some changes to our rewards system this year and would like to highlight the opportunities students have to receive rewards at Temple Moor and set out the criteria for these from the start.

Students will continue to collect positive stamps in lessons for demonstrating resilience, ambition and being reflective learners. They will also be rewarded for displaying positive behaviours and engaging in their learning. In addition, students will also collect value rewards for displaying one of our shared values (character, ambition, respect and endeavour).

Form tutors will collect in the positive totals each week and the pastoral team will visit forms to give out vouchers for our canteen for students with the most rewards and highest attendance. Every half term we have a celebration assembly where we present students with subject awards nominated by their teachers. In addition to this we have a tiered recognition system in which students will get the chance to watch a film or be entered for a prize draw, receive positive postcards home and enjoy VIP food and drink amongst other prizes. Students will be eligible for this if they have 95% attendance for that term, no seclusions and no more than one phase 4.

We will run a trip to Alton Towers in the first week back in September 2024. To be eligible for this trip students are required to have 95% attendance and no more than three seclusions or five phase fours across the year. This criterion also applies to Y11 students wanting to attend the school prom (further information around this will be communicated separately to Y11).

We hope those students who attended the awards evenings last week enjoyed the experience.

I hope by writing to you early in the academic year that we have clarified our expectations around rewards.
