Dear Parent/Carer,

At the start of this new term please see the below information as a reminder of our home learning policy.

Home learning serves an important purpose in supporting young people to make progress. Research by the Education Endowment Foundation (EEF) has shown that regular, high quality home learning can accelerate a student's progress by 6 months.

At Temple Moor we set high expectations for home learning. When students do not complete home learning then their subject teacher will allocate a negative comment on Arbor.

You can view students' attendance and behaviour daily using the Arbor app.

If a student fails to submit homework regularly then they are referred to study support 3:05 pm – 4:00 pm on a Wednesday with their Phase Leader for additional support. You will receive a message informing you of this before it starts. We have reset the home learning monitoring to give all students a fresh start this term alongside of this.

This referral means that study support is compulsory, and non-attendance will result in a sanction in line with our behaviour policy.
